- Self-sponsored delegates may book their accommodation directly with these hotels (a reservation code will be shared) or any other hotel of choice.
- These three hotels are located at the city's business and social epicentre, along KN 3
 Avenue. They are within a walking distance from each other and approximately ten kilometres from Kigali International Airport.



Expenses Covered



- All participants are responsible for their own expenses. This includes round-trip airfare to Rwanda, airport transfers, hotel accommodation, and any other costs associated with their stay in Rwanda.
- Any extras outside the communicated conference meal plan will be settled directly by meeting participants.



Travel Documents and Visa Arrangements

 All travellers must hold a valid passport (at least six months on the day of entry in Rwanda) or any other acceptable travel document, and the yellow fever certificate for travel into Rwanda.







- East African citizens can use the EAC pass.
- Citizens of country members of the following international organisations receive visas upon arrival and visa fees are waived for a visit of 30 days: African Union, Commonwealth and La Francophonie.
- Citizens of all countries that are not visa exempt also have the option to apply online or at the Rwanda Diplomatic Missions of their country of residence before departure. Those applying online have the option to pay online or upon arrival.
- Delegates holding diplomatic passports, service/official passports or AU/UN laissez-passer travelling for official duty are exempted from visa fees.

Those wishing to stay for longer than 30 days and/or enter more than once should contact the Directorate General of Immigration and Emigration or a Rwandan embassy or diplomatic mission.

There is no single affiliated agent authorised to apply for a visa on your behalf. Such agents may mislead you and charge more than the required visa fee (source: https://migration.gov.rw/visa-on-arrival).









Travel Insurance

While Rwanda currently has no specific travel insurance requirements, its tourism board encourages visitors to have adequate travel insurance to be taken out prior to departure.

This will cover any medical situation, cancellation, curtailment of arrangements and baggage.



Transportation

Transport from the Kigali International Airport and back will be provided for VIP's and Speakers in pool shared vehicles. Please look out for our representative holding a sign reading "Africa Trade Development Forum" at the designated areas in the arrival hall. They will assist you in locating your vehicle.

For your return to the airport, please be ready at the hotel concierge at least 3 hours before your scheduled flight departure. This allows ample time for the transfer to the airport.



About Rwanda



Time

The time in Rwanda is GMT+2



Climate

The temperatures in Rwanda in December are comfortable with lows of 60°F and highs of up to 78°F. Rain is expected at an average of 15 to 22 days of rain.



Power supply

The electricity supply in Rwanda is 220/240V AC. It is advisable to bring your own round, two-prong adapter and transformer for 110V AC.



Telecommunications and internet

The available mobile telecommunication service providers are MTN and Tigo/Airtel. Mobile telephone service providers also provide a gateway to the Internet using GPRS, 3G and 4G. Cell phone SIM cards are widely available.

Every SIM card user/buyer in Rwanda is expected by law to be registered prior to activation and SIM cards can be registered at the point of purchase.

Your passport will be required for SIM card registration. All hotels as well as the meeting venue provide internet connectivity.









Plastic bags

As part of an environmental protection policy, plastic bags are not allowed into Rwanda.

Passengers entering Kigali International Airport, or any other border posts with plastic bags are required to discard them and are supplied with an environmentally friendly alternative at a cost ranging between 2-6USD.



Currency

The unit of currency is the Rwandan Franc (RWF). Exchange rates are subject to fluctuation. Central bank rates can be found on the National Bank of Rwanda website www.bnr.rw Bureau de Change (Forex Bureaus) are available at the airport and in all parts of Kigali City.



Health and Safety (Mpox and Marburg)

The Ministry of Health and World Health Organisation are actively managing the situation. Rigorous contact tracing, case investigation, and active symptom screening at points of entry are in place to prevent any potential spread of the virus. Extensive measures have been taken to ensure the safety of both residents and visitors, and all necessary precautions are being implemented. We reassure the public that the situation is under control and traveling to and within Rwanda is Safe.

Banking Services

Banking hours are from 09:00 to 17:30 on weekdays and from 08:00 to 15:00 on Saturdays. Banking amenities are available at all commercial banks and most banks have cash dispensing machines accepting Visa. MasterCard and Cirrus.

Most internationally recognized currencies and travelers' cheques can be exchanged at commercial banks, hotels and international airport. Major credit cards are accepted in most hotels, restaurants and shops



Security

Although Rwanda remains a safe travel destination with relatively low crime rate, there may be cases of petty crimes. To mitigate this risk, meeting participants are advised to leave important documents and personal belongings in the hotel safe, limit the amount of cash carried, and exercise increased vigilance in crowded areas.

Business & Shopping Hours
